Parents Code of Conduct and Ethics



I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Parent's Code of Conduct:

- ◆ I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage good sporting like behavior of all players and peers by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support and extending respect for all players, coaches, officials and other sporting events.
- ◆ Accept the results of all games encouraging players to be gracious in victory and to turn defeat into victory by working to improve.
- ◆ Realize that all of our activities (instructional and competitive) are designed to enhance the growth and development of all of our players.
- ◆ I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
- ◆ I will use tactful, quiet, one on one discussion of any concerns, questions or ideas with coaches.
- ◆ I will not harass, heckle or otherwise disrespect opposing players, coaches, supporters and officials.
- ◆ I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs.
- ◆ Use my influence and authority to deter inappropriate conduct by other supporters towards officials and opponents.
- ◆ I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- ◆ I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect no matter what.
- ◆ I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning.
- ◆ I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard, and make my child feel like a winner every time.
- ◆ I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
- ◆ I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
- ◆ I will look for positives, and make a big deal out of them
- ◆ I will stay calm when my kids make mistakes, helping them learn from their mistakes.
- ◆ I will have reasonable and realistic expectations for my children.
- ◆ I will treat my children with respect, avoiding put-downs, sarcasm, and ridicule.
- ◆ I will emphasize teamwork, and help my child think "we" instead of "me"
- ◆ I will not raise any issue with the coaches until a 24 hour period has expired after the game
